



Concurrent user licensing




Two users can now share one license whenever one of the users is inactive.

When connecting multifunctional devices to **ScannerVisionTM**, counting the number of devices (and therefore the required number of licenses) by the number of IP addresses is the logical solution. But when people are using **aivika** to scan, which runs on desktop PCs and mobile devices, this would not work as the IP addresses change regularly, especially when using **aivika** on laptops and mobile devices.

The most logical solution would be to identify the connecting **aivika** client by the user that is being used to log in. This means that the user can work anywhere, without the risk of getting a message about an invalid license because of a changing IP address.

In **ScannerVision™** 9 we are introducing User Based Licensing. Currently this is only applicable to **aivika**. A user can use two types of **aivika** clients at the same time: PC and mobile. It will not work with two clients of the same type at the same time (PC & PC, or mobile and mobile).
